**Introduction**

Hallgate Primary School pupils wear their uniform with pride. Our uniform shows that we are part of the Hallgate Primary School community.

We have the highest expectations from our pupils with regard to school uniform and appearance and strongly believe that our high standards promote positive behaviour, support effective teaching and learning and contribute positively to the overall ethos of our school.

**School Uniform**

We encourage all pupils to wear school uniform and insist that all items must be labelled with the pupil's name.

**Pre-School (Foundation Stage 1)**

Uniform for preschool children is optional. However, a blue sweatshirt with the school logo is available for purchase, via the school website. Children in preschool do not need a PE kit in school.

**EYFS to Year 6**

- White shirt
- Bottle green v-neck jumper or cardigan
- Bottle green blazer (optional)
- Tie (bottle green and silver, wide stripe) (an elastic tie is available for children in EYFS and KS1)
- Grey skirt / grey trousers / grey shorts
- Black shoes
- Bottle green check dress / playsuit
- Tailored grey shorts
  
- For PE: House t-shirt, navy or black shorts, plimsolls. Trainers, sweatshirt and tracksuit bottoms for outdoor PE in autumn and spring terms

**PE Kit**

All years will need the following PE kit:

- House t-shirt (see below), navy or black shorts, plimsolls.
- Trainers, sweatshirt and tracksuit bottoms for outdoor PE in autumn and spring terms.

As part of the curriculum, your child will be participating in outdoor and indoor physical activities and will need appropriate clothing in school for this. Parents will be notified of PE days and children will come into school in their PE kit on these days.

Children without a PE kit will not be able to participate, for health and safety reasons, and parents will be contacted by school staff, if that is the case.



### Jewellery and Hair

Children are not permitted to wear jewellery in school, other than stud earrings and a watch. This is for health and safety reasons. If your child wears an item of jewellery for religious or personal reasons, please speak to the school office to seek permission for this.

Long hair should be tied back and hair bands should be plain; novelty bands are not permitted.

Children are not permitted to wear make-up during the school day for any reason. The wearing of nail varnish is discouraged and parents are asked to remove nail varnish as soon as practical, if their child has had painted nails for a special occasion.

### Labelling

**Please ensure that all items of clothing that are brought into school are clearly / permanently labelled and that your child knows where to look for his/her name.**

A lost property trolley is in the entrance near the school office.

**School staff will not be responsible for looking for lost items.**

### Uniform Purchasing

The following items can be purchased from school:

Jumpers, cardigans, ties, PE t-shirts, waterproof coats, book bags, knitted hats and caps.

These are all available via the school website and are paid for online, using a credit / debit card.

### Non-Compliance

All staff will monitor adherence to our Uniform Policy and class teachers will, in the first instance, alert parents to issues / concerns. Further breaches of school policy will be addressed by the Headteacher or a member of the Senior Leadership Team.

### Monitoring

The governing board monitors and reviews the Uniform Policy regularly, by seeking the views of parents, to ensure that they agree with and support the policy.

The most recent review took place in November 2024.
