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Children with Health Needs who cannot access education Policy

Aims

This policy aims to ensure that:

- Suitable education is arranged for pupils on roll who cannot attend school due to health needs;
- Pupils, staff and parents understand what the school is responsible for when this education is being provided by the local authority.

Legislation and Guidance

Responsibilities of the School

At Hallgate Primary School, we will work closely with the local authority to ensure that a suitable education for children with health needs who cannot attend school will be provided. Each pupil will be considered individually and guidance will be sought from relevant professionals.

Support is also available from the local authority tutoring service and this will be arranged by the school, if deemed appropriate, at the earliest opportunity.
