PE Kits

PE lessons are on Friday. Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct PE kit:

- T-shirt in the correct house colour
- Black, navy or grey shorts, leggings or joggers.
- Optional black, navy or grey hoodie/jacket.
- Trainers (Converse style shoes are not suitable)

We have been asked to remind you that tops and trousers should be **unbranded**. Football/rugby tops should not be worn in place of a t-shirt.

If a child is not in the correct kit, they will not be permitted to participate in the PE lessons. Inappropriate clothing, such as bright coloured hoodies, will need to be left in the cloakroom and not worn during lessons. Leavers hoodies are not school uniform and are therefore not permissible in PE lessons. A reminder that long hair should be tied up and any school-appropriate jewellery or watches must be removed.
