Key Information

PE days	Our PE days is Monday . Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit for the whole day. Long hair should be tied back and earrings removed.
Home reading	Children will receive a sharing book to enjoy at home. This book is not intended for the children to read but for an adult to read and discuss it with them. Later in the Autumn term, children will be sent home with a phonics book. These start as textless books, for the children to discuss and talk about the story. Once the children are ready, they will be given a phonics book for them to read with decodable words linked to their phonics level. The minimum expectation across the school is that children read three times per week with an adult at home. This should be recorded and signed by an adult in the reading record. This is checked every Friday.
Phonics	Children have phonics on a daily basis. On Friday a sound book will be sent home with the new phonemes that they have been learning. This will be updated each week so please return sound books on a Thursday . Please practise the sounds at home to support and embed their learning.
End of the Day	Children in Reception must be collect by an adult. They should wait outside the classroom door for their children to be handed over. If you wish to speak to an adult regarding your child, please wait until all other children have been dismissed. Any children going to after school club will wait inside the classroom and be collect by the after school team.
