Key Information

PE days	Our PE day is Wednesday . Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct PE kit for the whole day. Long hair should be tied back and earrings removed. If it is a wet day it is always a good idea to bring spare clothes and shoes. We try to get outside as much as possible.
Maths and Spelling	To best support their learning, children will move into different groups for maths and spelling each morning. This means your child might work with a different teacher for these subjects rather than their usual class teacher. Any questions can be directed to the class or the subject teacher.
Home reading	To support your child's learning, we expect all children across the school to read at home with an adult for 10-20 minutes each day. As soon as they finish a book, they can check their progress by completing an Accelerated Reader quiz in class.
Homework	Year 3 - To boost calculation speed and accuracy, children should regularly practice their addition and subtraction facts up to 20. We recommend spending 20–30 minutes per week on NumBots (Story Mode). A "little and often" approach is the most effective way to help them secure the instant recall they need. Year 4 - A huge part of the Year 4 maths curriculum relies heavily on multiplication, making quick recall essential. Children should aim for 21 minutes per week on Times Tables Rock Stars (Garage Mode), which is specifically designed to help them master individual times tables.
End of the Day	Children in Years 3 and 4 can be collected directly from their classroom doors. If your collection arrangements change, please notify the school office as soon as possible so we can pass the message on to your child.
