Key Information

PE days	Our PE day is Tuesday . Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct PE kit for the whole day. Long hair should be tied back and earrings removed. If it is a wet day it is always a good idea to bring spare clothes and shoes. We try to get outside as much as possible.
Maths and Spelling	To best support their learning, children will move into different groups for maths and spelling each morning. This means your child might work with a different teacher for these subjects rather than their usual class teacher. Any questions can be directed to the class or the subject teacher.
Home reading	The minimum expectation across the school is that children read every day, for 10-20 minutes, with an adult at home. Once they have finished a book, they can then complete a quiz on Accelerated Reader in school.
Homework	Year 3 children need to practise and learn their addition and subtraction facts to 20 to support their speed and accuracy when performing calculations. They need to spend 20-30 minutes per week on Numbots, working through the story mode. Little and often is the most effective way to secure the instant recall that they are aiming for. Year 4 children need to be able to quickly recall multiplication facts, as much of our mathematics curriculum relies heavily on this. The children should aim to spend 21 minutes per week on Garage (on Times Tables Rock Stars) which helps children to master individual times tables.
End of the Day	Children will be let out from door 6. Please let a member of staff know if a different adult will be picking up at the end of the day.
