Key Information

PE days	Our PE day is Friday . Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct PE kit for the whole day. Long hair should be tied back and earrings removed. If it is a wet day it is always a good idea to bring spare clothes and shoes. We try to get outside as much as possible.
Maths and Spelling	Each morning the children will be split into different classes for maths and spelling. This will mean your child might have a different teacher for maths and spelling than their class teacher. Any questions can be directed to the class or the subject teacher.
Home reading	The minimum expectation across the school is that children read every day, for 20 minutes, with an adult at home. Once they have finished a book, they can then complete a quiz on Accelerated Reader in school.
Mobile Phones	We understand that some children may need to bring a mobile phone to school. Please ensure that mobile phones are switched off at the school gate and are placed in the box in the classroom to keep them safe.
Homework	If they are not secure with their multiplication tables, 10 minutes a day should be allocated to Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) as much of our mathematics curriculum relies on the children being able to quickly recall multiplication facts. To support them for transition to secondary school, the Year Six children will also have additional homework set weekly. It will be available on Google Classroom and as a paper version.
End of the Day	Children in Years 5 and 6 are allowed to walk home on their own, please ensure that office are made aware as well as the class teacher. Please notify the office at the earliest convenience if pick up plans need to be changed so that we can inform your child.
